DIRECTIONS

Fly-ins: Taxi toward the FBO at the east end of the paved runway. Designated airplane parking is in the grass just east of the hangars and fuel.

Driving from Houston: I-10 East to Grand Parkway (99) South
Left under 99 onto FM 565 northeast bound.

Immediate Right on FM 2354, which will merge with FM 3180.

Continue south, and turn east (left) onto Lawrence Rd. You'll see the RWJ Airpark sign.

Turn Right (south) onto Lakeview Dr.

Lakeview will force left just before the runway and will become a very narrow road parallel to the runway. Watch for potholes. Continue to designated car parking area straight ahead onto grass parking area. Do not turn to the right as that is where airplanes will be taxiing. Car parking area is on the grass.

These accidents happen in both VFR and IMC conditions, during the day and at night. They are not limited to inexperienced or VFR only pilots. This presentation will explore some of the factors that can lead to loss-of-control and will provide some practical steps that can be taken by pilots to help avoid LOC. Attending this presentation will be eligible for WINGS credit.
